

Warsaw – Krakow – Wroclaw - Gdansk , Spring - Summer
8 days (7 nights): Sunday - Sunday

Program:

Day 1 – Sunday

Arrival to Warsaw, transfer and check-in in Hotel.

Walking Tour around Warsaw’s Old Town (listed on UNESCO Heritage List). In program: Old Town, Castle Square, Royal Route, St. John’s Cathedral, Barbican, the statue of Mermaid.

For those who wish – evening act in Sabat Theatre (with dinner). The most famous house of comedy, musicals and variety. The actors are high class Polish artists (dancers, singers, acrobats etc.), a special place with wonderful atmosphere.

Day 2 – Monday

Breakfast at the hotel.

An optional visit to the Polin Museum and after to the Jewish Cemetery with a local guide, where the outstanding personalities of prewar Warsaw lie and to Nozyk Synagogue which is still functioning as a daily place of worship.

An optional tour to the beautiful parks and palaces of Warsaw : Wilanów – the residence of King John III Sobieski , the Royal Łazienki Palace Park (with the Chopin monument and the Palace on the Water)

Transfer to Krakow by express train

Day 3 – Tuesday

Breakfast. Walking tour of Krakow - Old town : Main Market Square, St.Mary’s Basilic, Sukiennice Cloth Hall, Royal Route, Wawel Hill with Royal Castle and the Cathedral and many more.

An optional bus tour Auschwitz-Birkenau. Around 60 km to the west of Krakow is a small town of Oswiecim, where in 1940 a set of German concentration camps was established. Auschwitz-Birkenau were the largest German concentration camp, where more than 1.5 million prisoners were tortured and murdered during the Second World War. Auschwitz-Birkenau is preserved intact as a reminder of the crime committed against humanity here. The museum includes the ruins of crematoria, gas chambers, the railway platform and other objects of the former concentration camp.

Day 4 – Wednesday

Breakfast

Breakfast at the hotel.

An optional tour to Pszczyna, Promnice and Tyniec for every nature and castle lover. During this tour you will have a Chance to discover beautiful palace and park in Pszczyna, have a dinner in Promnice Hunting Lodge, and visit Tyniec Benedict Abbey from XI century.

Or

An optional Jewish Culture and History walking tour to show what remained of the Old Jewish Kazimierz which had been pulsing with life. We will walk around the famous Szeroka Street with Remu Synagogue, we will see fragments of the walls of the war Ghetto, original Schindler's factory in the city's industrial district of Zabłocie and the monument at the site of the former Death Camp in Plaszow.

Or

Folk dinner in restaurant

Or

An optional day trip to Zakopane – a town in heart of Tatra Mountains known unique folklore, unique architectural style, masterpieces of wooden architecture, nature and national regional cuisine. In a short time, the artistic community and the Polish elite recognized Zakopane as the favorite city of poets, actors and musicians. Nowadays Zakopane, a popular mountain resort in summer attracts walkers, in winter it becomes a real mecca of skiers and snowboarders from all over Poland and abroad.

Day 5 – Thursday

Breakfast. Bus transfer to Wrocław. Check-in in hotel

Walking tour around oldest and most beautiful Polish cities. The charm of Wrocław heightens the fact that the city stands on 12 islands, connected by "a hundred bridges." A visit to the beautiful Market Square, entering the Cathedral Island - the oldest part of Wrocław, a short cruise along the Odra river to reach the walls of the Centennial Hall - a unique place on the map of Poland where the history harmonizes with the modernity

Day 6 – Friday

Breakfast in hotel.

An optional tour to the Churches of Peace in Jawor and Swidnica - the largest timber-framed religious buildings in Europe, built in the former Silesia in the mid-17th century. And after to Książ Castle – one of the most beautiful castles in Poland.

Train transfer to Gdansk

Day 7 – Saturday

Breakfast in hotel

Walking tour around Gdansk Old Town with local guide.

An option tour to Hel with fish dinner.

Day 8 – Sunday

Breakfast in hotel.

An optional tour to Malbork Castle – the biggest castle in Poland.

Transfer to Warsaw and flight back.
